



2023 Enduro Rules and Procedures

THE RULES AND/OR REGULATIONS SET FORTH HEREIN ARE DESIGNED TO PROVIDE FOR THE ORDERLY CONDUCT OF RACING EVENTS AND TO ESTABLISH MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE REQUIREMENTS FOR SUCH EVENTS. THESE RULES SHALL GOVERN THE CONDITION OF SPEEDWAY EVENTS AND, BY PARTICIPATING IN THESE EVENTS, ALL RACEWAY COMPETITORS ARE DEEMED TO HAVE COMPLIED WITH THESE RULES. NO EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTY OF SAFETY SHALL RESULT FROM PUBLICATION OF, OR COMPLIANCE WITH THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS. THEY ARE INTENDED AS A GUIDE FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE SPORT AND IN NO WAY ARE A GUARANTEE AGAINST INJURY OR DEATH TO PARTICIPANTS, SPECTATORS OR OTHERS.

EVENT DETAILS

- \$5,000 to win guaranteed.
- 200 laps.
- Top 3 finishers will be paid once tech is completed.
- Concrete pit stalls are available to rent for \$25 per spot.
- On-site registration begins at 11:05 a.m. and ends at 1 p.m. Every driver/team must register, draw for starting position and pick up transponder prior to 1 p.m. to be eligible to compete.
- Mandatory pre-race tech begins at 11:05 a.m. and ends at 1 p.m. Every entry must pass pre-race tech prior to 1 p.m. to be eligible to compete.
- Mandatory drivers meeting at 1:05 p.m.
- Mandatory scorers meeting at 1:25 p.m.
- One (1) scorer required per entry.
- Scorer must purchase pit pass.
- Video will be used to verify score cards
- Lineup on front stretch begins at 1:45 p.m. Lineup deadline is 2:15 p.m.
- Opening ceremonies at 2:25 p.m.
- Racing begins at 2:30 p.m.
- RACEceivers and transponders are required. Transponders must be rented from the track for \$25. A driver's license and credit card are both required for rental and are returned upon returning transponder after event concludes).
- Standing starts and restarts.

- No cautions: The race will only stop for track blockage, fire, flips, safety concerns or major accidents. Red will be displayed. All cars must stop immediately. Anyone not stopping immediately will receive a five (5) lap penalty.
- Pitting is permitted in the designated work area only.
- Driver changes are not allowed.
- Alcohol is not allowed to be consumed in the pit area until the event has concluded. Any person suspected of being under the influence of any unapproved substance will not be allowed to compete and will not have any fees reimbursed.

1st Place: \$5,000

2nd Place: \$1,000

3rd Place: \$500

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Car registration fee is \$100 on or before November 3, 2023.

Car registration fee is \$150 after November 3, 2023.

Pit passes are \$35 per person. The driver, one scorer and any crew members must purchase pit passes.

Mandatory transponder rental fee is \$25.

CAR RULES

- **START:** Self-start with forward and reverse.
- **WHEEL BASE:** Maximum wheel base 116 inches. Minimum wheel base 96 inches.
- **WIDTH:** Maximum car width of 92 inches.
- **STEERING:** Center steering-type cars are not allowed.
- **WEIGHT:** With driver in car, must weigh a minimum 2,800 pounds and/or a maximum 3,600 pounds.
- **TIRES & WHEELS:** Four (4) tires and wheels only. Tires must have 20 psi to start. Top of tire measured from the ground may not exceed 32 inches. Wheels up to and including 8 inches in width may run any tire. Wheel covers are permitted but must be attached by at least 6 bolts on a beadlock ring. Mud and/or snow tires are not allowed.
- **BODY:** Cars must have hood, doors, rear quarters and a trunk or covered rear deck. Wings, spoilers, sideboards or any other body panels may not be adjustable from inside cockpit and/or by remote control. No part of the body may be made out of material more than 1/16 gauge thick. Nerf bars outside the tires are not allowed. Seats must have steel protection underneath. Lights on cars are not allowed. Clear lexan or acrylic plastic is not allowed anywhere on the car. Maximum 6 inch aluminum spoiler is permitted.
- **BUMPERS:** Must be completely welded on and/or chained. A bumper loop or chain is mandatory for towing purposes. The Vado Speedway Park is not responsible for any damages from towing or pushing. Sharp and/or pointed edges on bumpers or any other part of car is not allowed.
- **FUEL CELL:** Maximum of 32 gallons, securely mounted and protected. Fuel filter may not hold more than a quart and fuel line may not exceed more than 1/2-inch diameter and a maximum of 16 feet long.
- **ROLL CAGE:** Minimum of a four (4) point cage with a minimum of three (3) driver door bars with vertical supports securely welded, 1½ to 0.95 minimum is mandatory. All bars that can be touched by driver while driver is in the seat must have roll bar padding. Steel driver door plate and window net required. Ballast must be mounted with 1/2-inch bolts painted white with car number. Square tubing is not allowed.
- **DRIVE SHAFT:** Drive shaft must be painted white and must have at least one safety loop or chain.
- **BRAKES:** Must have working brakes.
- **SAFETY REQUIREMENTS:** Car must have minimum of three (3) windshield bars. Racing seat and five (5) point seat belt harness must be securely mounted to cage. Full-face helmet, fire suit, gloves and neck brace

required. Securely mounted small fire extinguisher is required. Fuel-injected cars must have electric master disconnect mounted on rear deck behind driver. Batteries must be securely mounted and terminals must be covered.

- Working RACEceiver for driver is required. Any other radios, communication devices and/or scanners are not allowed. Rearview mirrors are not allowed.
- NUMBER: Cars must have large, easily readable contrasting color numbers on doors and roof.
- POWERTRAIN: Four (4) wheel and/or all-wheel drive vehicles are not allowed.
- COCKPIT: One passenger is allowed. Passenger must meet all safety requirements as driver. Car must have three (3) passenger door bars, steel plate under seat, steel door plate, passenger window net and roll bar padding same as driver.
- MUFFLERS: Any car running headers must run mufflers. Mufflers are not required for cars with manifolds.
- TRUCKS: Southwest Super Trucks are legal to compete. No other truck is permitted for this event.
- All cars and/or equipment must be removed from the Vado Speedway Park property by 5 p.m. on Sunday, November 15, 2023.
